Proposes to construct 1210 square feet of paved driveway in front yard and add new front yard circular driveway with new 12 foot wide southerly curb cut.

MAYOR SULLIVAN: Thank you. Anyone want to call the first case.

MR. LOUIS SANTORA: Sure. I think it is the two gentlemen over there. Identify yourself or state your addresses and everything.

VITO PASQUALE: Vito Pasquale, 433 Franklin Avenue, Lynbrook.

EDWARD VARGAS: Edward Vargas, 34 Johnson, Malverne, New York.

MAYOR SULLIVAN: Welcome gentlemen. Vito, you're up.

VITO PASQUALE: We would like to install a circular driveway in front of the house. It is a little bit of an issue there backing out of the driveway. I have done it a few times. Eric has, other people. It is a little dangerous. You cannot see the pedestrians as they're coming behind you. If you get caught at the train or the light, you're kind of stuck there. I figured it would help the new owner that will be, one day, to get in and out and be safer that way.

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Also, I think it's very nice and it helps to alleviate any parking on the street there because it is a little tight also.

TRUSTEE PRIZZI: The existing driveway goes down?

VITO PASQUALE: It goes down, yes. The problem is when you back up, your tail is up. You can see to the right or left of you.

That's why we kind of came up with this idea.

We figured it would help a lot.

MAYOR SULLIVAN: I was, in the past, opposed to these kinds of driveways especially on Hempstead Avenue because I wanted to retain as much grass space as possible. I get it, you know. You're not the first applicant to come to us for this. The more I see them, the more I realize it does pose a difficulty, you know and can may be a safety issue.

VITO PASQUALE: We're a house away from the parking lot. People walking there all the time. A lot of kids in the morning, kids going to Lourde's, coming out of school, the library, Lourde's, stuff like that. It is really unsafe the way it is.
