Mayor's Message – The Hempstead Avenue utilities project is coming to an end. Hempstead Avenue will be repaved curb to curb after July 4th. The 2026 Village road paving project will follow shortly thereafter. Cornwell gas and water mains will be replaced next year followed by repaving. Nassau County has approved a mid-town crosswalk on Hempstead Avenue.
